Appropriate comparability data includes compensation levels paid by organizations of similar size and complexity nationally, regionally and locally, and current compensation surveys.

Detailed documents are maintained of all deliberations and decisions.

The process of determining the compensation of the President & CEO last included review and approval by independent persons, comparability data and contemporaneous substantiation in 2022. The Executive Committee delegates to the President & CEO the authority to set compensation for other executives.
